Esther Webb dies in Fairview

Esther Selina Webb passed away in Fairview General Hospital on May 9, 1983 at the age of 73.

She was born in Gilroy, Saskatchewan, Oct. 11, 1909, daughter of Erik and Anna Olson. In 1926, the family moved to the Griffin Creek district, south of Brownvale.

Esther married Harry Webb on July 3, 1933 and they farmed at Griffin Creek until 1973, when they retired and moved to Fairview. In the winter months, they travelled to a warmer climate and for many years they resided at Mesa, Arizona.

She was active in community activities, being a member of the Women's Institute, and FWUA. She enjoyed curling in her younger years. Esther was a member of the Fairview Golden Age Club.

Esther is survived by her husband Harry; four children: Bernice and husband Charlie Glen and
